In conjunction with the 21st annual Boscov's Berks Jazz Fest weekend we're happy to highlight the local jazz group, Gamut. This dynamic quintet, formed in 2009 and headed by keyboardist Erwin Chandler and saxophonist Ken Blekicki, present live performances that truly run the gamut of musical styles -- from jazz standards to contemporary jazz to original compositions.

Their newly released CD, *Arrival*, features 10 songs — many written or arranged by Chandler and Blekicki, who are joined for this performance by Bob Carl on bass, Bobby Livingood on trumpet and John Rozum on drums.

Members of the quintet are first-call musicians, and have been featured sidemen with artists such as Jimmy Dorsey, Frank Sinatra, Sammy Davis, John Lennon, Johnny Mathis, Henry Mancini, Simon & Garfunkel, Billy Joel, Liza Minelli, and more.
