Come help celebrate the season by being part of the Reading Public Museum's 6th Annual *Yuletide Around the World—Festival of Trees*. Join other community organizations as they decorate holiday trees inspired by customs, traditions or symbolism of their cultures.

- Have your community organization represented in the galleries of The Museum
- Trees will have artwork paired from The Museum's Collection when possible

Requirements

- Organize community volunteers to decorate a holiday tree or display showcasing the traditional holiday celebrations of your group's homeland and provide cultural decorations.
- Trees or displays will be decorated the week of November 14 with the final day to decorate is Sunday, November 20, 2022.
- Trees or displays will then need to be dissembled by community volunteers between the close of the exhibition on Monday, January 9 and Friday, January 13, 2023.
- Groups should encourage members of your community organization to come visit the display throughout running time of the exhibition.
- The Museum has a limited number of trees available, and they will be distributed on a first come first serve basis. Organizations may be asked to provide their own tree.
- If an organization is interested in supplying their own tree, they may do so. Trees must be artificial, no taller than 84" and no wider than 45" at the widest point.
- Organizations should plan to supply all decorations and lights for trees.
