PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS:

Scout in-person ½ day workshops are offered 7 days a week between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

- ½ day workshops typically run 3 hours in length and include day-of Museum admission
- Select 1 badge/adventure or outing

Scout in-person full day workshops are offered 7 days a week between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

- Full day workshops typically run 6 hours in length, include an hour break, and include day-of Museum admission
- Select 2 badges/adventures or outings

Scout **to-go kits** are available for select badges and adventures – please contact Rebeka at rebeka.birch@readingpublicmuseum.org for program offerings

- Each kit includes instructions and materials for one scout to complete a badge/adventure in full
- Each kit includes a return pass for a scout to visit The Museum OR Planetarium
- Shipping is available upon request for an additional fee

Scout overnight workshops are offered Friday and Saturday evenings beginning at 6:00 p.m. and ending at 8:30 a.m.

- Available for all levels of scouts Lions and Tigers MUST be accompanied by at least 1 adult per scout
- Siblings MAY be permitted for an additional fee on a case-to-case basis
- Includes a light continental breakfast and evening snack, other options may be available for an extra fee
- Select 1 badge/adventure or outing

- COVID-19 POLICIES will be sent to your group PRIOR to your visit RPM follows current recommended CDC and PA State
 Guidelines
- **CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY** your troop MUST provide the museum with a certificate of liability insurance (this is free of charge from you insurance company or from your council contact them to make arrangements please issue it to The Reading Public Museum).
- Upon receiving this reservation form, The Museum will process your program request your program is not confirmed until you receive your confirmation AND deposit payment is received.
- Payment is required in advance for ALL workshops, to-go kits, and overnights. Final payment and final attendance numbers are due no later than ONE WEEK before your workshop.
- There are NO REFUNDS for cancellations, no-shows, or over payments.
- One scout leader or adult must be present for every 10 scouts. You may NOT leave your scout(s) alone in the workshop. Scout leaders are responsible for the behavior of their scouts.
- Badges are not provided for workshops, unless specified or requested and prepaid.
- Workshops are only for scouts working on the badge and their adult. Siblings will be permitted on a case-to-case basis and will require additional fees to attend and/or participate in activities.
