AGREEMENT

- Masterpiece Weddings Wedding Showcase (hereafter referred to as "The Showcase") is a rain or shine event.
- All exhibitors are required to bring their own extension cords for booths needing electric.
- All exhibitors are required to bring their own table linen, unless purchased as an A La Carte Item through the Reading Public Museum (hereafter referred to as "The Museum").
- Exhibitor booths must be completely setup by 11:30am. The Showcase will begin promptly at 12pm.
- The Fair ends at 3:00pm. Tear down prior to this time will not be permitted and may result in forbiddance to attend future showcases.
- Exhibitor décor, signage, banners and the like are not to interfere with neighboring booths.
- All exhibitors will unload in The Museum's driveway off Museum Road in front of the tent, and then park
 their car in the Scottish Rite Cathedral lot and walk down through The Arboretum to return to the tent.
 Tear down and reloading will occur in reverse order.
- Horns, bells, alarms, confetti, birdseed, open flame, and fog machines are strictly prohibited.
- Any décor, signage, or banners that require hanging will be permitted at the discretion of Museum staff.
 Easels, sign holders, or materials to hang signage or banners from your table are strongly encouraged. The Museum will NOT provide personalized signage for each booth.

- The Museum is not responsible for the damage or loss of articles prior, during, or after The Showcase. Exhibitor tear down must be completed by 5pm.
- Booth space is not reserved until the exhibitor's invoice is paid in full, regardless of whether the contract has been submitted. All applications and payment must be received by Friday, September 14, 2017.
- Exhibitor agrees not to share booth space with another company or organization, including the display of another business's marketing material.
- Booth space may not be resold or given away to another person or business.
- The location of each exhibitor's booth is determined by Museum staff and will not be changed under any circumstance.
- Payment for The Showcase is non-refundable. The exhibitor will not be reimbursed, in full or in part, if he or she can no longer attend.
- All exhibitors are required to submit a certificate of insurance, which must waive all rights of subrogation against The Museum and must name both the Reading Public Museum and the Reading School District as additionally insured.
- Exhibitor agrees to hold harmless and indemnify The Museum for any and all claims for bodily injury or property damage arising from The Showcase.
- Exhibitors requesting the non-profit booth rate must supply proof of their 501(c)3 status.
- Exhibitor agrees not to share attendee contact information with other parties.
- The Showcase may be videotaped or photographed by Reading Public Museum staff and/or our Preferred Photographer. By signing this application, the exhibitor consents to the use of faces, names, likeness, trade name, and trademark of the company and its representatives in such photographs and videotapes and the commercial use of such photographs and videotapes.
- Two exhibitor representatives per booth are encouraged to provide proper coverage for meals, breaks, etc. No more than four exhibitor representatives per booth.
- The Museum cannot guarantee a specific number of brides to attend The Showcase. Exhibitors are not entitled to a full or partial refund based on attendance.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complying with all federal and city safety and fire laws. Smoking is prohibited under the tent. All decorations must be flame retardant.
