PROGRAM TOPICS:

SILLY SCIENCE:

Topics covered include – Polymer science (slime), chemical reactions, and physical properties.

FORENSIC SCIENCE

Topics covered include - trace evidence, DNA extraction, and handwriting analysis.

SPACE ADVENTURE

Topics covered include – space exploration, life cycle of stars, constellations, planets, and the solar system.

DIGGING DINOS

Topics covered include – types of fossils, the fossilization process, and dinosaur adaptations.
